

Heartland Volunteer Lifeguard Job Description

Responsible To: Summer Camp Director

Minimum Qualifications

- Have a relationship with Jesus Christ and desire to share God's love in all that you do
- Have experience with pool maintenance
- Have previous lifeguard experience/certification from a nationally recognized organization
- Very high work ethic and ability to work long hours
- Ability to handle emergency situations and recall first aid training
- Must be at least 16 years old

General Responsibility

To support Heartland's mission by creating and maintaining a safe and welcoming environment for campers and guests every time they are at the pool. To attend all swimming activities that are assigned by the Program Director during the week.

Specific Responsibilities:

1. In partnership with the lead lifeguard instruct groups on rules and discipline in a firm but polite manner
2. In partnership with the lead lifeguard facilitate a deep end test for all interested each Monday
3. " " testing chemicals daily to ensure the proper balance and safety and logging
4. " " cleaning when needed; vacuum, cleaning filters, take out trash, cleaning gutters and drains, spray and sweep the deck
5. " " cleaning daily; all showers, dressing rooms and bathrooms, clear benches and collect lost items, pick up all trash around the facilities
6. " " keeping a log of all First Aid given at the pool facility
7. Following all ACA Standards
8. " " providing at least one water break per swim
9. " " lock the facilities, turn off the lights each day
10. Physically able to travel the trails and roads that connect the program elements and facilities of Heartland camp grounds

Essential Functions:

- Ability to work long hours in the heat and keep focused
- Ability to stay focused and work independently until necessary tasks are complete, to include working non-traditional hours to make certain the job is done well
- Ability to lead all pool facilities, keep them safe, clean and maintained
- Ability to enforce rules and keep high expectations
- Ability to act quickly in emergency situations
- Be a team player
