Minimum Qualifications:

- Have a relationship with Jesus Christ and a passion for sharing God's love through everything you do
- Experience with horses; riding, saddling, grooming etc.
- Confidence with horse behavior and handling emergency situations
- Experience with kids and riding instruction
- Must be at least 16 years old

General Responsibility:

To Support Heartland's mission by creating a safe and welcoming environment for all campers, staff and volunteers during horse rides and instruction.

Specific Responsibilities:

All responsibilities are done in partnership and under the direction of the Lead Wrangler

1. To provide a safe horse experience.
2. Bring horses in each morning
3. Keep horses well feed, groomed, and healthy
4. Assist with any other camp duties, or help fellow staff with other tasks
5. Maintain equipment
6. Keep tack shed clean and well maintained
7. Ability to enforce rules while being loving and firm
8. Physically able to travel the trails and roads that connect the program elements and facilities of Heartland camp grounds
9. Follow all ACA standards
